11 Easy Steps to Earn a Merit Badge

1. Decide which merit badge that you would like to earn.
2. Look at www.meritbadge.org to see what the requirements are for that merit badge.
3. Get a copy of the merit badge pamphlet. Each requirement will be fully explained in the pamphlet.
4. Get your "blue card" from the Scoutmaster. He must approve your choice of merit badges. You must keep up with this card. It will have to be turned in when you complete the mb requirements.
5. Find out who the counselor for your merit badge is.
6. Contact the counselor and ask them if they would be able to work on that merit badge with you.
7. If they are available, discuss what your will need to do to complete the requirements. If you need to meet on Tuesdays, merit badge work cannot be done during troop meetings, only before or after the meeting.
8. You may NOW begin working on the merit badge.
9. Once you have completed all work to complete the requirements, ask the counselor to sign your "blue card".
10. Fill out the "blue card" completely.
11. Return the "blue card" to Mrs. Donna or Mr. Tracy Ellis.
